

## ANTI-CORRUPTION DAY REPORT

The Debates & Seminar Committee of Government Degree College Pulwama in collaboration with Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) Anantnag (South Kashmir) organized a seminar on 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2024, on the observance of "**International Anti-Corruption Day**". The theme of this seminar was "*Role of an Individual in Eradicating the Menace of Corruption*".

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**Report on Art of Living Youth Program for College Students in Jammu and Kashmir  
(Youth Empowerment and Skills Workshop)  
(24-09-2014-27-09-2024)  
(Detailed Report)**

Four days training workshop on "Youth Empowerment and Skills Workshop (Yes!+)" was organized by the Art of Living Foundation in collaboration with the Higher Education Department Jammu & Kashmir in the Mini Auditorium of GDC Pulwama (Host College) from 24<sup>th</sup> September 2024 to 27<sup>th</sup> September 2024 (10:30 am to 1:30 pm) for 6 colleges including GDC Pulwama (20 students), GDC Women Pulwama (20 students), GDC Tral (20 students), GDC Pampore (10 students), GDC Rajpora (10 students), and GDC Awantipora (10 students). The Career Counselling Committee and Academic affairs Committee were organizers in the host college.

**Day 1**

The proceedings of the workshop started with the inaugural session at 10:30 am wherein Prof Waseema, Convenor Career Counselling Committee of the host college, presented welcome address and appreciated and congratulated the organizers for conducting the workshop. Mr. Avinash Tikoo, Director, Youth affairs, The Art of Living Foundation gave introductory remarks about the workshop. Founded in 1981, by H.H. Gurudev Sri Sri Ravi Shankar, Mr. Avinash Tikoo enlightened that The Art of Living Foundation offers highly effective educational and self-development programs and tools that eliminate stress and foster deep and profound inner peace, happiness and well-being. He emphasized that The Art of Living reinforces human values and brings people from varied social, economic, geographic, cultural and religious backgrounds together in a spirit of Service and Celebration. These programs include breathing techniques, meditation, yoga, and practical wisdom for daily living. The Art of Living is present in 152 countries, reaching an estimated 300 million people worldwide with a vision of individual and social stewardship in society. This was followed by a brief lecture by Ms. Mahika Sharma, a dedicated full time faculty member in Art of Living Foundation wherein she briefly discussed about the life skills as the abilities for adaptive and positive behavior that enables individuals to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life. Afterwards Mr. Avinash Tikoo briefly explained the program schedule for 4 days dividing the content into 12 modules - Personality Development (5 modules), Social Adaptability and Effectiveness (4 modules) and Professional Skills (3 modules).



After introductory session, a series of interactive exercises started:

Activity 1: Introduction by all the participants. This activity was aimed at fostering a sense of connection and mutual belonging among participants.

Activity 2: A riddle test where participants had to resolve riddles. This activity was to emphasize the importance of listening and encouraging careful attention.

Activity 3: Participants were encouraged to ask questions based on what they had heard. This activity highlighted a variety of questioning techniques and emphasized how effective communication is to be required.

Activity 4: To go into the past and think what things bother and generate anxiety. The students were made aware about Psychosomatic Disorders

Activity 5: Many exercises were being performed to uplift energy among students.



## Day 2:

This day was the Happiness Program

Powerful breathing techniques were being performed that can change one's life. The main aim was to equip oneself with practical knowledge and techniques to unlock one's true potential and bring fullness to one's life. These exercises were being performed to foster well-being through breath, meditation & yoga and to eliminate stress and help individuals develop their highest potential.

Students were made to perform different exercises that taught them to take a right decision, to win the races, to be more responsible towards academics, family and take up ownership for their acts.

Students were taught through different activities how opposite values are complementary to each other.



### Day 3:

SKY—a powerful rhythmic breathing technique was being done that harmonizes the body-mind complex. Participants noticed reduced stress and anxiety, better sleep, a stronger immune system, and increased energy levels. A combination of asanas and other relaxation exercises were being performed to encourage a calm state of mind, to improve memory and retention and specialized processes to increase confidence and concentration. The workshop provided students with a comprehensive toolbox to manage their emotions and stress as well as dynamically navigate through adolescence. This program broadened vision and provided practical knowledge and skills to realize the highest potential. After undergoing the program, students will acquire enhancement of creative skills, improved memory and concentration, development of leadership qualities and healthy emotions, clarity of mind as well as improved interaction with their peers. It imbibed a passion for excellence and instilled a spirit of volunteerism in the students, creating a strong foundation for nation building. The two main take aways of this day were: "Don't be the football of other people's opinion" and "Don't see intentions behind other people's mistakes."





#### Day 4:

The two trainers explained the seven levels of existence- body, mind, breath, intellect, memory, soul/self and ego. They provided insights into how these elements interact and influence the overall wellbeing. This was followed by different activities based on compliments for one other as a mark of respect.

This session was followed by valedictory session wherein certificate distribution ceremony was held, all the participants are acknowledged for successfully completing the workshop. This was followed by concluding remarks by the worthy Principal of the host college Prof. Harris Izhar Tantray wherein he emphasized the importance of such initiatives for the overall development of the students. He highlighted the role of workshops in fostering mental, emotional and physical wellbeing which are essential for personal and academic growth.

### Continuing Medical Education (CME) 2024

Theme: Immunology CME: Latest Developments and Techniques

Venue: Auditorium, Govt. Degree College Pulwama, J&K, India

Date: 16th October 2024

The Department of Biotechnology, Biochemistry, and Clinical Biochemistry at Government Degree College Pulwama organized the Continuing Medical Education (CME) 2024 on the theme "Immunology CME: Latest Developments and Techniques" on 16th October 2024. The event was attended by I/C Principal, Prof. Irfana, who served as the patron for the day.

#### Inauguration:

The event began with an introduction by Dr. Shah Ubaidullah, Assistant Professor of the Department of Biotechnology. He introduced the resource persons for the CME, each of whom delivered insightful lectures on various aspects of immunology. Dr. Qudsia Rashid and Dr. Sabreena from the Department of Clinical Biochemistry and Biotechnology served as rapporteurs, documenting the event proceedings.

Organizing Secretary, Dr. Niyaz Ahmad Naikoo, provided an overview of the CME program, highlighting the objectives and relevance of the session. This was followed by a formal welcome by Prof. Irfana, I/C Principal, who, in her address, emphasized the vital role of immunology in addressing emerging health threats and ensuring public safety.

#### Technical Sessions:

The first session featured a lecture by Dr. Shaida Andrabi, Associate Professor, Department of Biochemistry, University of Kashmir, on "Flow Cytometry and Immunohistochemistry." Dr. Andrabi discussed in detail the importance of these techniques in disease diagnosis.

The second lecture was delivered by Dr. Syed Hussain Mir, Assistant Professor, Department of Clinical Biochemistry, University of Kashmir. His talk focused on "Principles and Modalities of Immunodiffusion Techniques: RIA, ELISA, EIA/SPOT, and Western Blotting." Dr. Mir compared the various immunological techniques, highlighting their diagnostic applications in healthcare.


Dr. Intiyaz Ahmad Bhat, Consultant in Biochemistry and Immunology at Unipath Specialty Laboratory, Srinagar, delivered a lecture on "Immunological Markers, Diagnostics, Immunotherapy, and Drug Targeting." His presentation covered the latest advancements in immunological diagnostics and their clinical implications.


Dr. Muzammil A. Malikdoomi, Assistant Professor of Biochemistry at Govt. Degree College Garidbal, spoke on "Immune Regulation, Immune-Unresponsiveness, Tolerance, and Autoimmunity." His talk provided a detailed overview of immune system regulation and its role in autoimmune diseases.

The final lecture of the day was delivered by Dr. Shahid M. Baba, Assistant Professor at the Centre for Vocational Studies, Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST). He discussed "Immuno-inflammatory Mechanisms and Hypersensitivity Reactions," offering a comprehensive explanation of different types of hypersensitivity.

At the end of the event, certificates were distributed to the registered participants, recognizing their active involvement in the program. The event concluded with a formal vote of thanks by Dr. Shah Ubaidullah, followed by a group photograph session. Nearly 150 faculty and students from various colleges participated in the CME-2024 event.

The CME 2024 was a highly informative and successful event, offering valuable insights into the latest developments in immunology, diagnostic techniques, and therapeutic approaches.

To celebrate maiden "National Space Day-2024" Department of Chemistry and Department of Physics in collaboration with Research Committee and IIC, Govt. Degree College Pulwama organized a One Day Workshop to engage and inspire youth towards the advancements of space technology and its applications. The program started with the opening remarks by Ms. Yasmeen Gul, Associate Professor Department of Physics. In her brief introduction, she highlighted the significance of the Day as being the maiden National Space Day. The day marks a year of completion of successful landing of Vikram Lander from Chandrayaan-3 of Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO). She underlined that India made history on this day last year by becoming the fourth nation to successfully land on Moon and the first to reach its southern polar region. She also emphasized on the theme for this year's National Space Day - "Touching Lives while Touching the Moon: India's Space Saga" highlighting India's achievements in space exploration i.e. journey from launching satellites to landing on the moon.

The first speaker of the day, Dr Gowhar Hussain Bhat, Assistant Professor, Physics, Govt. Degree College, Shopian, in his address, highlighted the achievements of ISRO in space technology and the prestige, sovereignty and international leadership that country has achieved in space science and technology.

## Workshop Report

### Two-Day Hands-On Workshop on "Basic Molecular Biology Techniques" Organized by the Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, and Biotechnology Government Degree College (Boys) Pulwama

**Venue:** Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry & Computer Applications

The Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, and Biotechnology successfully organized a two-day workshop titled "*Basic Molecular Biology Techniques*" on 20th and 21st November 2024. #### Day 2: Agarose Gel Electrophoresis and Knowledge Assessment

The second day of the workshop focused on **agarose gel electrophoresis**, a technique used to analyze the PCR products from the previous day. Participants prepared and ran agarose gels to separate and visualize the DNA fragments amplified during PCR. This session emphasized critical lab skills such as gel preparation, sample loading, and result interpretation.

To evaluate the participants' understanding of the techniques taught, a **quiz session** was conducted. This activity encouraged active participation and allowed the students to demonstrate their learning outcomes.

### **Feedback and Certificate Distribution**

At the conclusion of the workshop, participants provided their feedback, sharing their learning experiences and suggestions for future workshops. The feedback highlighted the hands-on nature of the sessions, which the participants found particularly beneficial for understanding molecular biology techniques.

## **Report on One-Day Hands-on Workshop on "SDS-PAGE (Sodium Dodecyl Sulfate Polyacrylamide Gel Electrophoresis)"**

**Organized by:** Departments of Clinical Biochemistry, Biochemistry, and Biotechnology, Government Degree College (GDC) Pulwama

### **Introduction:**

The Departments of Clinical Biochemistry, Biochemistry, and Biotechnology, GDC Pulwama jointly organized a One-Day Hands-on Workshop on "SDS-PAGE" on 25 April 2025. This workshop was conducted under the DBT Star College Scheme supported by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India. The primary objective was to familiarize undergraduate students with SDS-PAGE, an essential protein separation technique widely used in molecular biology and biochemical studies.

The event was aimed at providing experiential learning in laboratory-based protein analysis techniques and enhancing scientific skill development among students. The workshop specifically targeted students from the 4th and 6th semesters of the three organizing departments.

### **Technical Session:**

## ONE-DAY WORKSHOP ON ELECTORAL PROCESS

### **Report**

A one-day workshop on Electoral Process was conducted by SVEEP committee in the Mini-auditorium of Government Degree College Pulwama on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 in anticipation of upcoming General Assembly Elections of UT of Jammu and Kashmir. It was organized to develop awareness about the importance of electoral participation and to give participants hands on training regarding voting process. The workshop aimed at guiding first-time voters comprehensive information on their rights and responsibilities as voters. As such, the workshop was to educate participants on the electoral process, create awareness about the importance of voting and encourage voter registration, especially among young and first-time voters.

The workshop began with a brief introduction to SVEEP and its initiatives aimed at increasing voter turnout. Prof. Imtiyaz Ahmad (Convener SVEEP) provided an overview of the electoral process, including the significance of each step from voter registration to casting of vote. The presentation embodied explanation of roles of various bodies such as the Election Commission of India (ECI), State Election Commissions, and polling officers. The importance of free and fair elections in a democracy was emphasised. Detailed guidance was provided on how to register as a voter with an emphasis on the eligibility criteria. The use of the National Voters' Service Portal (NVSP) for online registration was demonstrated. The facilitator highlighted the power of each vote in shaping the future of the nation. Real-life examples were used to show how voter turnout can influence election outcomes. Documentary on casting of vote on Electronic Voting Machine was screened to students. Students and staff members were given the opportunity to practise casting a vote using a mock EVM set up. A good number of first-time voters appreciated the demonstration of polling mock drill which reduced their concerns about using these machines on election day. The workshop played a crucial role in motivating attendees to participate actively in the upcoming elections, thereby contributing to the strengthening of democracy in the country. Prof (Dr.) Haris Izhar Tantray, worthy principal of the College, presented concluding speech whereby he highlighted the significance of vote in making democracy a success.

## Report on Workshop on Virtual Labs

### Introduction:

The Department of Clinical Biochemistry, GDC Pulwama, organized a workshop on **Virtual Labs** on 2 May 2024 to provide students with hands-on virtual experience in fundamental biochemical techniques. The workshop was specifically designed for students enrolled in Clinical Biochemistry as a Major, Minor, or Core subject. By integrating technology-driven simulations, the event aimed to enhance conceptual clarity and practical understanding of key biochemical experiments.

### Objective:

The primary objective of this workshop was to introduce students to the use of **Virtual Lab simulations** as an alternative platform for practicing and understanding experimental biochemistry. ### List of Experiments Performed:

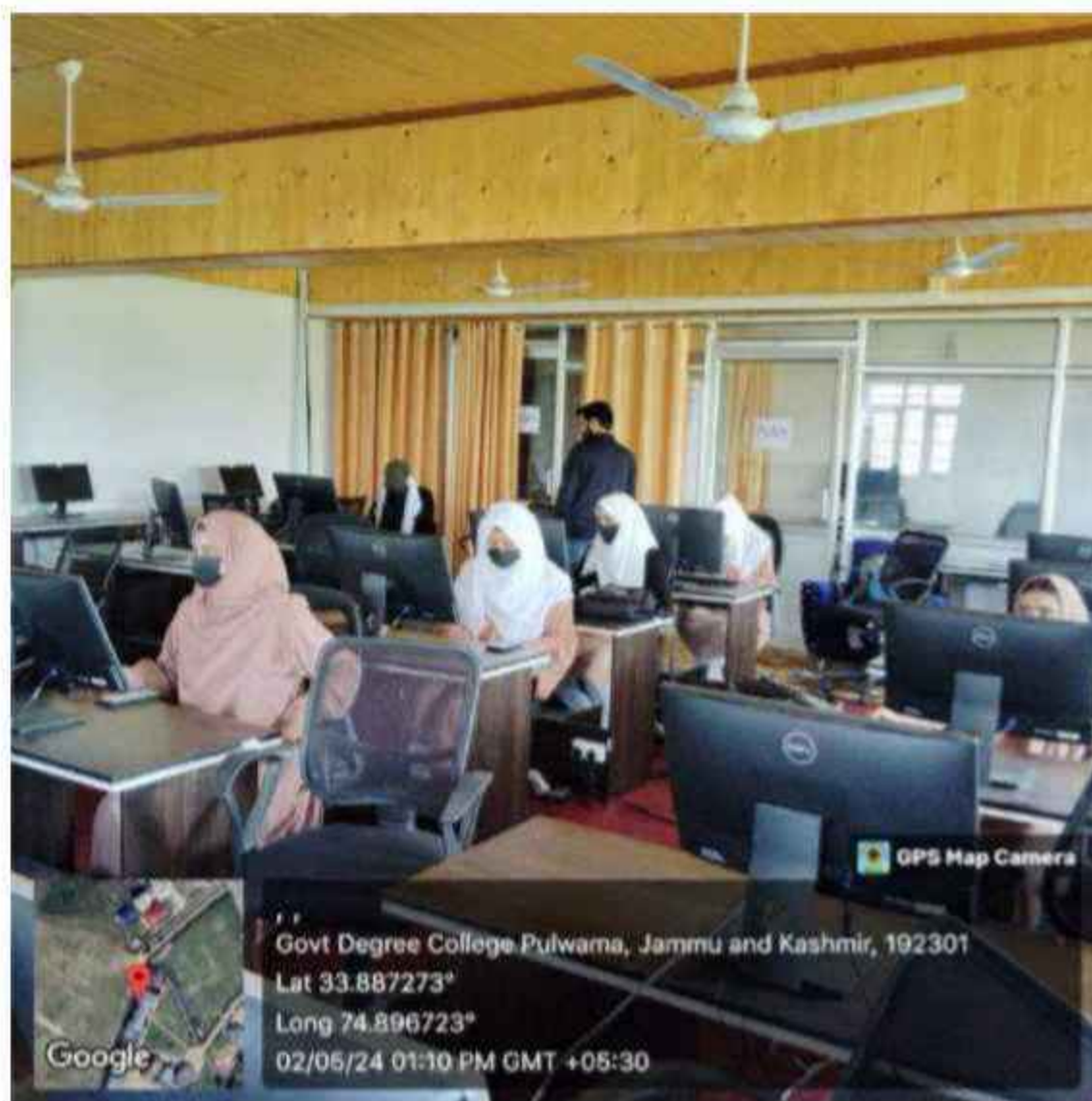
1. **Qualitative Analysis of Carbohydrates** (*Biochemistry Virtual Lab I*)
  - Students performed virtual tests to identify the presence of various carbohydrates using chemical reagents such as Benedict's, Barfoed's, and Molisch's tests.
2. **Estimation of Glucose in Serum** (*Biochemistry Virtual Lab I*)
  - A step-by-step virtual simulation of glucose estimation using enzymatic methods helped students understand clinical applications of glucose analysis.
3. **Quantitative Estimation of Amino Acids by Ninhydrin** (*Biochemistry Virtual Lab I*)
  - The experiment involved the colorimetric estimation of amino acids based on their reaction with ninhydrin, including plotting of standard curves and calculation of unknown concentrations.

### Student Participation:

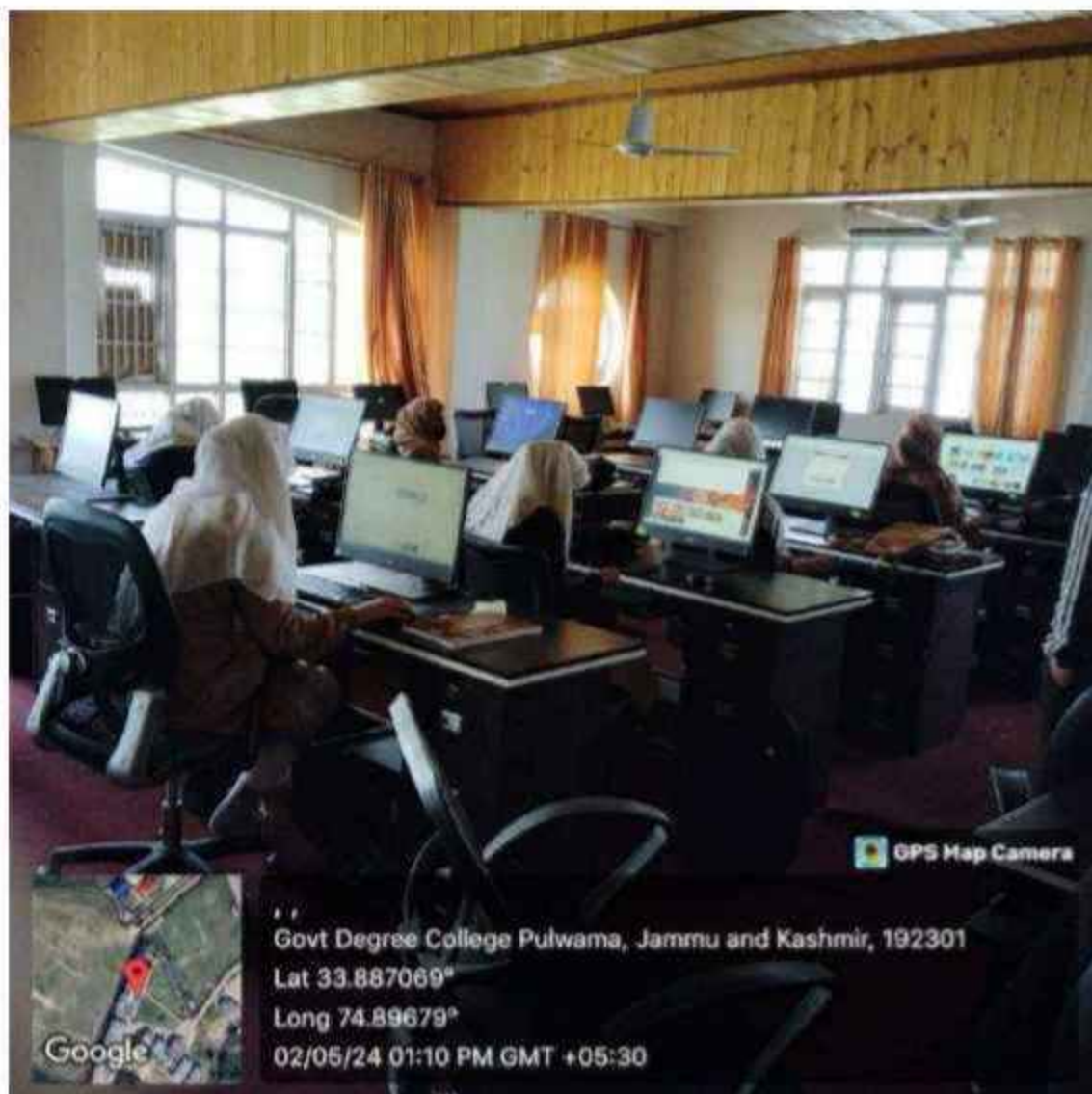
