



## Workshop Report

### Two-Day Hands-On Workshop on “Basic Molecular Biology Techniques” Organized by the Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, and Biotechnology Government Degree College (Boys) Pulwama

**Dates:** 20th and 21st November 2024

**Venue:** Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry & Computer Applications

The Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, and Biotechnology successfully organized a two-day workshop titled “*Basic Molecular Biology Techniques*” on 20th and 21st November 2024. The primary objective of this initiative was to provide students with theoretical knowledge and hands-on experience in fundamental molecular biology techniques, including PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) and agarose gel electrophoresis.

This workshop was attended by 5th-semester students of Biological Sciences and served as a valuable platform to enhance their practical skills, foster critical thinking, and deepen their understanding of molecular biology research tools.

#### Day 1: Primer Designing and PCR

The first day of the workshop began with an engaging presentation by Dr. Tasaduk Wani, from the Department of Biochemistry. His presentation covered the *Basics of PCR*, including its technique, applications, and types. Additionally, Dr. Tasaduk provided a detailed introduction to primer designing, explaining its principles and significance in molecular biology experiments.

Following the presentation, the participants engaged in a technical hands-on session on **primer designing**. Under the guidance of faculty members from the organizing departments, each participant worked on designing primers using bioinformatics tools. The session provided students with an in-depth understanding of how to design primers suitable for specific PCR reactions, equipping them with essential skills required in molecular biology research.

In the subsequent laboratory session, participants performed a **PCR reaction**. They prepared samples, set up PCR reactions, and gained first-hand experience with the amplification process. The faculty provided step-by-step guidance throughout, ensuring students grasped both theoretical and practical aspects of the technique.

#### Day 2: Agarose Gel Electrophoresis and Knowledge Assessment

The second day of the workshop focused on **agarose gel electrophoresis**, a technique used to analyze the PCR products from the previous day. Participants prepared and ran agarose gels to separate and visualize the DNA fragments amplified during PCR. This session emphasized critical lab skills such as gel preparation, sample loading, and result interpretation.

To evaluate the participants' understanding of the techniques taught, a **quiz session** was conducted. This activity encouraged active participation and allowed the students to demonstrate their learning outcomes.

### **Feedback and Certificate Distribution**

At the conclusion of the workshop, participants provided their feedback, sharing their learning experiences and suggestions for future workshops. The feedback highlighted the hands-on nature of the sessions, which the participants found particularly beneficial for understanding molecular biology techniques.

Finally, participation certificates were distributed to all attendees, recognizing their successful completion of the workshop.

### **Conclusion**

The workshop achieved its objective of equipping students with essential molecular biology skills. It provided a comprehensive blend of theoretical insights and practical exposure, enhancing the students' competence in techniques widely used in modern biological research.

The Departments of Biochemistry, Clinical Biochemistry, and Biotechnology are committed to fostering an environment of practical learning and look forward to organizing similar events in the future.





The list of activities performed during October-December 2024 and January 2025.

#### October 2024

The department in collaboration with the College landscape Committee made a comprehensive weekly schedule for the development of college landscape. As the month of October experienced no rainfall, therefore it was decided to water the plants in the beds and along the avenues. **Besides, watering, mulching was also done to protect the plants from soaring heat.** In this programme not only the students of the department but faculty members and non-teaching staff also participated.

In the month of October the Local Fund Employees of the college were also engaged in cleaning of the college campus. This activity was performed on weekly basis on each working Friday. The campus was cleaned not only from any garbage but also from any noxious weeds.



#### November, 2024

In the joint venture of the department of botany and the College Landscape Dev.Committee, the College Landscape was cleaned from the garbage and unwanted weeds in the campus. The campus was divided into seven regions and each region was allotted to a group of Local Fund Employees. Each member of the College Landscape Committee was appointed as an observer to look upon the progress of the work. The activity helped to maintain the college campus beautiful and also helped to maintain the college playground functional.

The department completed the process of internal (practical) examination after datesheet for the same was published by the college administration. The examination ended smoothly and the concerned examiners

Keeping in view the approaching winter, which experiences snowfall, the expert advice is to go for pruning and clipping of the foliage and branches of different trees and shrubs in the campus. This programme was almost successfully completed in the month.



**January, 2025:** As the recent snowfall was heavy and it damaged certain trees mostly cypresses, therefore it was decided that to protect them from the further damage and clear these plants from the broken branches, a pruning and clipping reinforcement is necessary. The Landscape Development Committee and the department jointly carried out the extension of **pruning programme**. The perennial shrubs were pruned to protect them from the possible damage threat from the snow




