4. An abridged one page synopsis that includes title, research questions/hypothesis/objectives and importance of work be included in the agenda, the detailed synopses be considered by the DRC and a copy of the same shall be kept available at the time of BORS.
5. Departments should explore possibility of co-supervisors for research scholars from premier Institutions such as IITs etc. It was strongly felt that co-supervision of only such teachers/scientists from outside the University should be sought/considered who bring certain expertise/experience that is not available in the University.
6. Heads of Deptts. shall arrange workshops for assessment of work problem/orientation to the scholars for preparation of synopsis.
7. Heads of Deptts/Deans of Schools shall ensure that there is no repetition in the topics chosen for research in the allied Centres/Deptts.



PROPOSED TITLE

Designing strategies for synthesis of bioactive heterocyclic compounds and bioprospection of different phytoconstituents of medicinal plants of Kashmir region

**Questions asked/Objectives of Research Work:**

1. To undertake synthesis of bioactive heterocycles and their SAR studies
2. To conduct a Regular field survey for collection of important medicinal plants from different zones of Kashmir region.
3. To perform Chemo profiling of Natural isolates using different analytical techniques (chromatographic-techniques, HPTLC, Column chromatography, Hydrodistillation etc) for the separation of active principle components from plants.
4. To characterize isolated compounds by spectroscopic techniques like  $^1\text{H NMR}$ ,  $^{13}\text{C NMR}$ , MS, IR, GC-MS etc

**Design of the sampling procedure/sample size/experimental set-up/replication:**

Different kinds synthetic strategies will be employed to synthesize potent bioactive molecules. Structure activity relation of the synthesized molecule will be checked after proper characterization of molecule. The collected plant material will be subjected to hydrodistillation, extraction. The bioactive lead molecules will be isolated from the extract through column chromatography. Techniques like HPTLC,  $^1\text{H NMR}$ ,  $^{13}\text{C NMR}$ , MS, GC-MS, IR will be utilized to characterize compounds.

**How this research is going to be an addition to the already existing knowledge on the topic:**

Rise of newly mutagenic pathogens has created a wide space of work on development of new and more effective pharmacophores. Natural products have been the most successful source of potential drug leads. However, their recent implementation in drug discovery and development efforts have somewhat demonstrated a decline in interest. Nevertheless, natural products continue to provide unique structural diversity in comparison to standard combinatorial chemistry, which presents opportunities for discovering mainly novel low molecular weight lead compounds. Keeping in view the global and national state of affairs of medicinal plants in consideration, it is worth to develop an approach that explores both plant based and synthetic resources to produce potent bioactive molecules.



## Minutes of meeting regarding launch of AVSAR (connecting to opportunities initiative) programme in District Pulwama

A meeting of various district officers was held under the chairmanship of District Development Commissioner Pulwama on 13-12-2023, for launch of AVSAR (connecting to opportunities initiative) programme in district Pulwama.

At the outset of meeting, the chairman briefed that the AVSAR programme being an initiative program in Jammu & Kashmir that aims to connect the youth of the region with various opportunities for personal and professional development. The program focuses on providing training, mentoring, and networking opportunities to empower young individuals and equip them with the skills and knowledge necessary to succeed in today's competitive world. The program also emphasizes inclusivity and diversity by reaching out to underprivileged communities and ensuring that all youth in Jammu & Kashmir have equal access to the resources and opportunities.

Chief Planning officer Pulwama informed that a meeting in this regard has been held on 25-10-2023 wherein various decisions have taken for running the AVSAR programme. It was decided that the District Administration will initially start free super-50 NEET coaching to economically backward/under privileged students (including under privileged NEET dropouts of last year) of the district having strong academic records in medical stream in 12<sup>th</sup> class and aspire to pursue various competitive exams in medical subject especially NEET 2024 in the first phase of AVSAR programme in district Pulwama. The ideal location for running the programme has been already identified at Govt. Degree College Boys Pulwama which requires up-gradation for smooth conduct of AVSAR programme in the building. Accordingly R&B Pulwama has been authorised to undertake necessary up-gradation of identified AVSAR centre on urgent basis. Since the identified AVSAR centre at Govt Degree College Pulwama is under the process of up-gradation and to start the super 50 NEET coaching the Principal GDC Boys Pulwama has agreed to spare two lecture halls for running the programme during winter vacation period till the AVSAR centre is made functional. However, the Principal Degree college has requested to put the college campus on hot line service of PDD for uninterrupted electricity.

After threadbare discussions, following decisions were also taken and approved by District Development Commissioner Pulwama for smooth implementation of AVSAR programme in the district:



**About Field Station Bonera, Pulwama**

The Field Station Bonera, Pulwama of the CSIR-IHM Jammu is one of the largest research, development and extension stations for high value medicinal, aromatic, spice and nutraceutical crops spread over an area of 60 hectares, situated at a distance of 35 kms. from Srinagar in the South Kashmir area of district Pulwama at an altitude of 5400 ft above mean sea level. The output and importance of the station is significant in terms of the development of agro-technological protocols, post-harvest management, processing and extension of MACs under temperate agro-climatic conditions. The farm is under intensive cultivation of different medicinal and aromatic, spice, and nutraceutical crops on commercial scale especially Lavender, Rose, Scented geranium, Clarysage, Artemisia, Saffron, Rosemary besides many other minor aromatic crops and culinary herbs. The farm activities consist of R&D for agro-processing, post-harvest management, production of medicinal and essential oil-bearing crops and their value-added products, generation quality planting material of high value cash crops, trainings and capacity building and involve conservation of high altitude temperate medicinal and aromatic plant species. The farm is recognized as one of the best for research, development and extension on temperate medicinal and aromatic crops, especially in lavender cultivation and extraction of lavender essential oil.

The purpose of this visit was to educate the students towards various research activities which have been practiced in the premier research labs in government sector. Students got a chance of demonstration of cultivation practices and extraction of essential oils. Dr. Shahid Rasool, gave an elaborate lecture on cultivation and extraction of aromatic and medicinal plants in India with special reference to Jammu and Kashmir. Students visited various cultivation fields of different medicinal and aromatic plants. During the visit, students

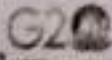



undergraduate students with all the requisite skills needed to run or work in various child day care centers or ICDS.


ICDS is a government program in India which provides Food, Preschool Education, and Primary health care under 6 years of age and their mothers.

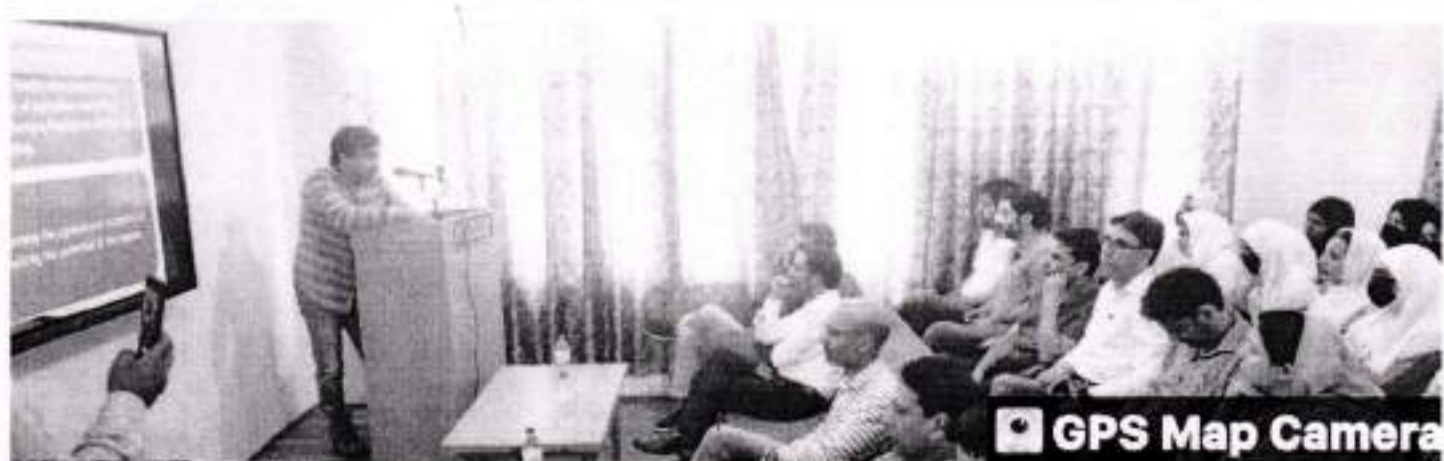

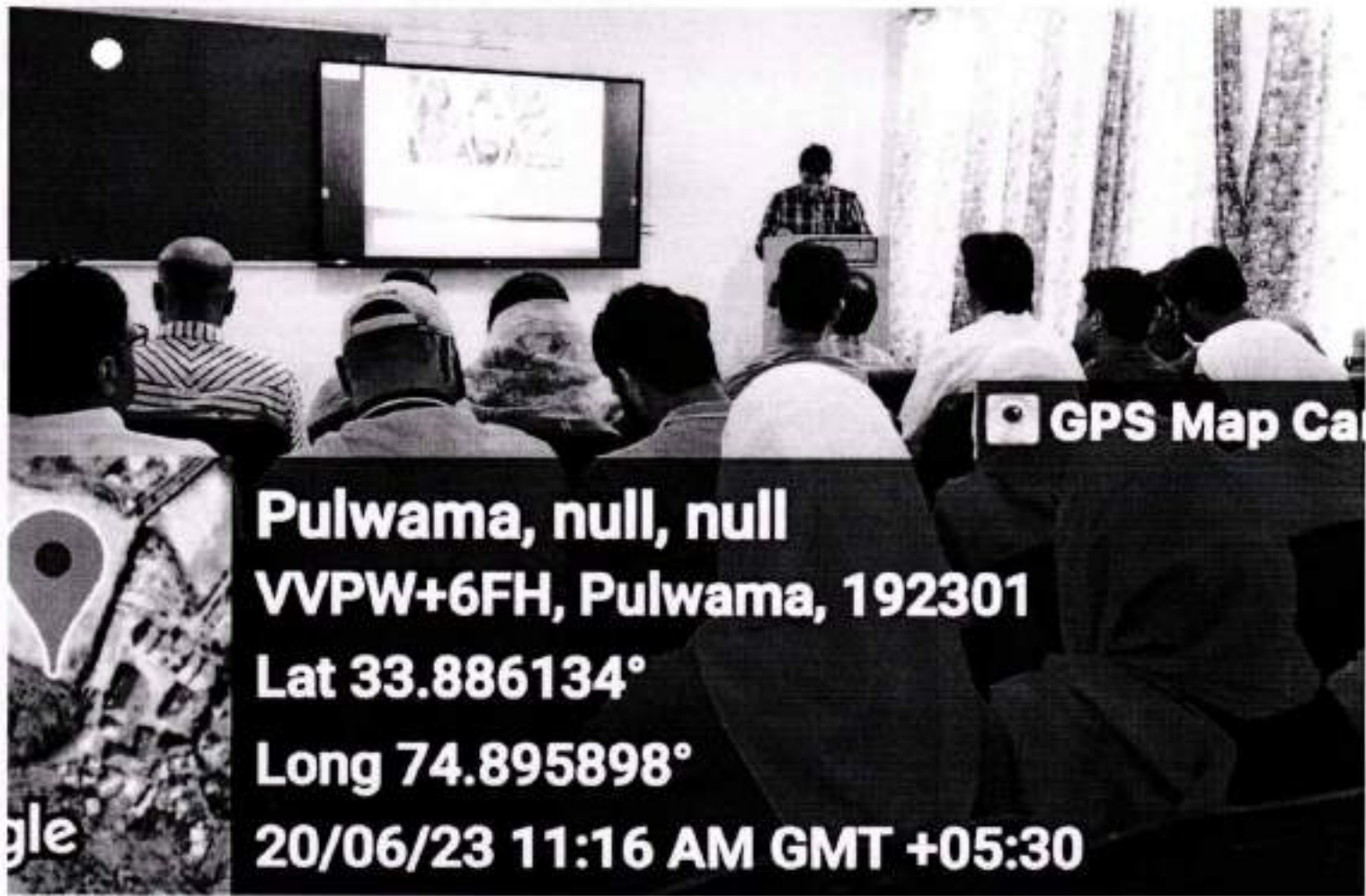


### Visit to District Public Library, Chatapora Pulwama: A report
